**WRITTEN WARNING AND ORDER TO CORRECT
FOR NON-COMPLIANCE WITH COVID-19 SAFETY STANDARDS**

Pursuant to COVID-19 Order No. 33 “Order Implementing A Phased Reopening of Workplaces and Imposing Workplace Safety Measures to Address COVID-19,” COVID-19 Order 37 “Authorizing the Re-Opening of Phase II Enterprises,” and COVID-19 Order 43 “Order Authorizing the Re-Opening of Phase III Enterprises,” M.G.L. c. 149, §§ 6, 6½, and M.G.L. c. 111, § 30, the Massachusetts Department of Labor Standards (DLS) is charged with the responsibility to investigate compliance with COVID-19 workplace safety rules and to enforce said rules.

The Massachusetts Department of Labor Standards issues this Written Warning and Order to Correct to the business, organization, or enterprise (Respondent) listed below. Respondent is required to provide proof of correction by the due date specified. Any business, organization, or enterprise that fails to comply with the General Workplace Safety Rules or applicable Sector-Specific Rules, per COVID-19 Order Nos. 33, 37 and 43, and this Written Warning shall be subject to the issuance of a Civil Citation and Civil Penalty with a fine of up to \$300 per violation. Continued non-compliance with COVID-19 workplace safety standards will subject the business/organization/enterprise to a Cease and Desist process to stop operations of the business/organization/enterprise until compliant.
